GRIEF SHARE

It may be hard for you to feel optimistic about the future right now. If you have lost a loved one, you have probably found there are not many people who understand the deep hurt you feel. This can be a confusing time when you feel isolated and have many questions about things you have never faced before. Grief Share groups meet weekly to help you face these challenges and move toward rebuilding your life. On Sunday, August 11 from 6:00pm to 8:00pm we will have a special session of Grief Share that specifically addresses the Loss of a Spouse. Then, beginning Sunday, August 18 from 6:00pm to 8:00pm we will begin a 13-week series of Grief Share. Each session has three distinct elements: a video, group discussion, and personal study with your workbook. You are welcome to begin attending the Grief Share group at any session.
